**81 captions** with a barcode visitors can scan to listen to one minute of the conversation Martin had with the person photographed.









Our arrival coincided with the election and I found myself craving kindness and authentic connections. This led to my project, which was born out of a desire to find compassionate Chicagoans from all walks of life and highlight our shared humanity. My journey led me, sometimes by chance, to a wonderfully diverse and eclectic range of people, each threaded together by integrity and a sparkling inner light.

My subjects shared their open and unfiltered stories with me, which I have carefully curated for this show. I explored the City through them and the magic of each inspiring encounter lifted my heart and opened my eyes to a world of endless possibilities.

There are 81 portraits in the show, all of them rcode next to the subject's name. Please SCAN this barcode. This will take you

to Soundcloud where you will hear the subject speak for up to a minute.

Under each portrait, you will find their corresponding sound station title (i.e HIM, HER, etc). If you would like to hear more of ersation, please then go to their sound station.

18 sound stations are positioned on pillars throughout the show and are clearly signed. At each sound station you will find a list of names alongside their job titles and image number. You will also find a barcode.


#### ABTIST BIO
